
Royal Roads University is located on the traditional Lands of the Lekwungen-speaking Peoples, the Songhees and Esquimalt Nations.



Food & Drink



On-Campus Learning

Attending daily classes with your cohort while studying full-time in Victoria helps focus your learning, allows you to fully engage in the course content and connects you with local cultural organizations and communities for experiential learning.

Enhancing team-building and team-based learning, being on-campus also grants you daily access to faculty, administration staff and campus resources to deepen your education.

Online Learning

Designed to be engaging and challenging with just the right amount of guidance, our online programs give working professionals the flexibility to maintain their lives, manage their families and advance their careers.

Blended Learning

Pathways to Royal Roads

The undergraduate programs at Royal Roads are degreecompletion programs comprising the final two years of a fouryear degree. Undergraduate students typically complete the first two years of their degree or diploma at another recognized college or university then transfer to Royal Roads to complete the final two years. In some programs, our accelerated model allows students to complete years 3 & 4 in as little as 12 months.
