If you ARE doing an Internship:

You will complete 42 credits (typically 14 courses) in your area of focus

- Justice Studies
- Professional Communication
- · Business and Sustainability

You may choose to complete up to 12 credits at the 300/400 level at other institutions as part of your academic specialization. Courses must be approved by the Dean of the College of Interdisciplinary Studies and a Letter of Permission (LOP) must be obtained prior to signing up for the external courses.

If you have already taken courses at the third- or fourth-year level at other institutions you may be able to transfer these courses into the academic specialization as long as these courses have not already been applied to a degree credential and as long as they are related to your program of study.
