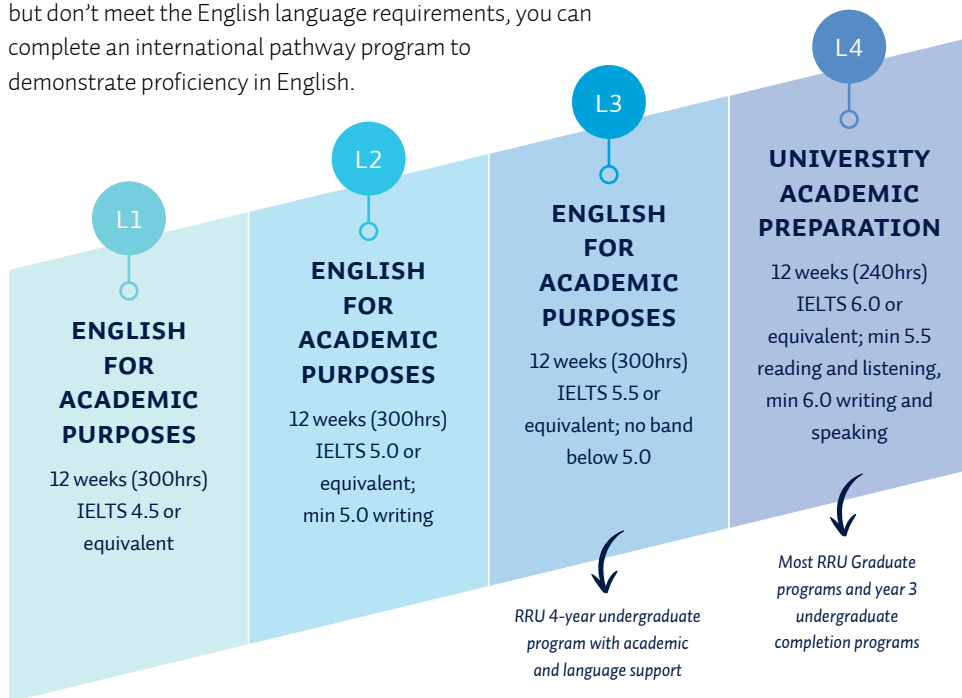

Applied English Programs

Our Applied English programs will help you activate your English language skills and learn to apply them in your real-world contexts. You will strengthen your overall language proficiency through an integrated skills curriculum and then focus on developing your ability to operate in the language in the applied life and career situations of your choice.

Choosing one of the applied options listed below will give you the opportunity to apply your language skills to a specific area of study and strengthen your ability to operate effectively in English in this chosen context.

Global English and Academic Skills

Improve your overall English language proficiency, expand your global awareness and learn effective academic English strategies. Select the program intensity that works best for you.

- Intensive (25 hours per week)
- Semi-Intensive (20 hours per week)
- Standard (15 hours per week)
- Advanced Academic Preparation (20 hours per week)

Global English and Business Communication

Through the combination of an integrated skills curriculum and focused business communication training, this program will help you expand your vocabulary, build knowledge and refine your spoken and written communication skills so that you have increased confidence to interact with colleagues from around the world.

Global English and Leadership

Gain the skills, confidence, and awareness you need to connect with people across boundaries and to lead positive change in your life, organizations and communities. This one semester program blends professional and personal leadership, team-based projects and exposure to RRU's award-winning Learning, Teaching and Research Model alongside an engaging integrated skills curriculum.

SUMMER LEADERSHIP ACADEMY

Summer Leadership Academy students will gain leadership skills while heightening English and intercultural competencies. Blending experiential and challenge-based learning, this program actively engages students to apply their learning to actionable projects in teams with the objective of making positive change in the world, both locally and globally. It is designed for students with moderate English language ability.

1. TEST YOUR LEVEL OF ENGLISH

Our programs are designed for students who have at least a low-Intermediate level of English. Take our free online English assessment to determine whether you are ready to study with us.

2. CHOOSE YOUR PROGRAM

- Review the descriptions.
- If the program offers different intensity levels, consider which one is best for you.

3. CHECK THE REQUIREMENTS

We have programs from low Intermediate to Advanced levels of English. Check the minimum English language requirement for your program. An official language proficiency test-score report can help confirm placement in a specific level or program. If you do not have an official test score, final placement will be determined by a test on the first day of the program.

4. APPLY

Complete our online application and pay the non-refundable application fee (if applicable).

5. APPLICATION APPROVAL

- If your application is approved, you will receive email confirmation from the GLLC with details regarding how to pay your tuition deposit
- Pay your tuition deposit to secure a seat in the program
- Receive a Letter of Acceptance, which you will need to obtain your Visa (if required)
- Pay remaining balance at least 28 days prior to the program start date
